



## Talking Points for the California Gubernatorial Recall Election

- As we still navigate this pandemic, stay safe when you cast your ballot. Vote by Mail, vote early and stay healthy
- Whether you want to vote in-person or by mail, there's a safe voting option that fits your needs
- This election will run like any statewide election in Los Angeles County, but this election is unique because there are 46 candidates who will appear on your ballot
- In this election - your ballot will ask two questions that will each be counted separately
- The two questions on your ballot: Do you want to recall (remove) the Governor? And if the recall is approved, who do you want to replace him?
- If more than 50% vote YES, the Governor will be removed from office and the candidate with the most votes would replace him
- If more than 50% vote NO, the Governor will remain in office
- First time voting? Visit [LAVote.net](https://LAVote.net) to easily register today so you can Vote by Mail and stay safe
- Los Angeles County has made it easy for you to make your voice heard by sending every registered voter a Vote by Mail ballot



- Voters can track their mailed ballot every step of the way but subscribing to Where's My Ballot ([california.ballottrax.net](http://california.ballottrax.net))
- You can mail your ballot or drop it in a Ballot Drop Box near you
- A list of the nearest Ballot Drop Box locations to your residence is included in your Vote by Mail package and a full list of drop box locations is available online at [LAVote.net](http://LAVote.net)
- You can avoid the long lines at Vote Centers – Vote by Mail today
- Early in-person voting will be available at a Vote Center beginning September 4
- Vote Centers will be open every day from 10 AM to 7 PM, these hours are extended on Election Day, September 14 to 7 AM to 8 PM
- If you vote in-person you can save a lot of time at the Vote Center by making your selections with the Interactive Sample Ballot
- The Interactive Sample Ballot lets you make your selections and creates a QR code to easily transfer your selections at the Vote Center
- Any eligible voter who missed the registration deadline (8/30) can visit a Vote Center and cast a ballot via Conditional Voter Registration
